

Did you know?

Over the past decade, two people and countless animals died in 625 livestock production and storage facilities costing over \$56 million in damage.

Barns and agricultural buildings used for other things have additional code requirements.

Check with your local fire department for considerations unique to your farm.

PROTECT YOUR ANIMALS

- Keep heat lamps and space heaters at least 3 feet from anything that can burn.
- Inspect heating equipment annually.
- Use extension cords on a limited and temporary basis.
- Clear dust and debris from lights and outlets.
- The barn is a smoke-free zone.
- When possible, store hay, straw and feed away from the main barn.
